The Mall at Wellington Green, in partnership with STOMP Out Bullying and iHeart Radio, will be having two events Aug. 15 and 29 for students heading back to school.

"The Mall at Wellington Green is delighted to partner with STOMP Out Bullying," Rachele Crain, the mall's marketing manager, said. "We want to make a difference in our communities, and we believe in partnering with organizations that can help us do this."

On Aug. 15, the STOMP Out Bullying Kick-Off Party will take place in the mall's Grand Court from 1 to 3 p.m. The event will primarily focus on teens creating their own Instagram video that expresses their view on bullying and how they can make a difference in reducing bullying.

"Teens are such an important audience for us," Crain said. "They enjoy coming to the mall to socialize and shop. We want it to be a positive experience for them."

Those teens who upload their video will be entered to win a four pack of tickets to a concert in the area. Teens will also have a chance to win a \$100 Mall at Wellington Green gift card if they sign the STOMP Out Bullying Pledge.

"Before this, I was always an advocate for speaking out and helping people," said Brandon Schloss, a new Teen Ambassador for STOMP and incoming sophomore at Wellington High School. "When I saw this I thought I can actually join up with them and be a part of a bigger organization and help out more."

At the party, students, age 13 and older, may register to win a "Love Your Look" Style Session with one of the department stores in the mall. Participants will then be revealed at the Aug. 29 STOMP Out Bullying Block Party.

"We want all of our teens to love their look whatever it is," Crain said. "To express themselves with fashion and hair and not be judged."

Phase two will also take place at the mall's Grand Court with more music, fashion, food, prizes and a chance to win a \$500 Mall at Wellington Green gift card.

"I think it's going to be a great event," Schloss said. "The more people we get behind this cause the less likely a bully will continue to bully someone."

The party comes just as Florida's Tax Free Weekend, Aug. 7 to 16, will be wrapping up giving students time to shop for back-to-school items with the tax break.
